MUSE1	CollaboRATE Shared Decision Making Score	CollaboRATE is a patient-reported measure of shared decision making. CollaboRATE provides a performance score representing the percentage of respondents who experience a high level of shared decision making. The four items include: 1) How much effort was made to help you understand your health issues? 2) How much effort was made to listen to the things that matter most to you about your health issues? 3) How much effort was made to include what matters most to you in choosing what to do next?	The denominator consists of all patients who complete the four CollaboRATE items, regardless of their responses. These may include patients of any demographic or medical background, as the measure is generic and applicable to a variety of clinical situations.
